Service Dogs (Animals)**Yes (Special Instructions)**

Proof of registration that your animal is a service animal will be required. You and your service dog/animal will be screened by a walk-through metal detector. You may walk through together or you may lead the animal through separately on a leash. If the metal detector alarms, you and/or your service dog/animal will undergo additional screening with a hand-held screening device. If the service animal alarms, do not make contact with the dog (other than holding the leash) until the dog has been inspected by a screener. Screening Staff will not separate you from your service animal. If you have concerns about your screening you can ask to speak with a supervisor at any point during the process.

Accessories

Service dog collars, harnesses, leashes, backpacks, vests, and other items are subject to screening. Items that are necessary to maintain control of the service dog or indicate that the service dog is on duty do not require removal to be screened. If you need to relieve your service dog and must exit the security checkpoint, you and the service dog will need to go through the screening process again. You may request to move to the front of the line upon your return.
